## Amazing Fact

An Advent wreath contains candles of two different colours. There are three purple candles which symbolise hope, peace and love. These candles are lit on the first, second and fourth Sundays during Advent. On the third Sunday, a rose coloured candle is lit which symbolises joy. Sometimes a fifth candle (usually white) is placed inside the centre of the wreath to be lit on Christmas Day.
