







Can you see any shelters?

What feeds the earth?








Can you see things that are trapped?



Can you see things that are free to move or grow?




As you notice things changing do you think they are happy?




One of Jesus' friends told lies about him and Jesus was arrested. Although He had done nothing wrong a crowd of people chose for Him to die.





Jesus stumbled through the city and was crucified on a hill called Golgotha. Crowds of people who had followed him now stood watching him die.


Can you see anything that has struggled?

Where can you see choices?






Are there any dark spaces or areas?

As Jesus was dying all the light left the land and then the earth shook. It was almost as though the earth was speaking as the God who made it now left it.






A shadow
